


Figure 1: IMAGE OF ABERDEEN OFFSHORE WIND FARM (NOT TO BE USED FOR NAVIGATION PLEASE NOTE CARDINAL BUOYS HAVE BEEN REMOVED FROM SITE)

Figure 1 shows the wind farm area outlined in red along with cable routes in blue where vessel will be operating.

## **SCOPE OF OPERATIONS**

SURVEY INSPECTION OF ELEVEN TURBINE JACKET/STRUCTURES BOTH ABOVE AND BELOW WATER AREAS ALONG WITH CABLE ROUTE SURVEY.



### **SCHEDULE**

DATE OF OPERATION START: 18TH AUGUST 2019

TIMES OF OPERATIONS: 12 HOURS

LENGTH OF OPERATION: 31<sup>ST</sup> SEPTEMBER (DEPENDING ON WEATHER)

### **AREA OF OPERATIONS**

The area of operations is the site of the European Offshore Wind Deployment Centre in Aberdeen Bay (AOWF).

All works will occur within the Development Area (marked in red in Figure 1 and cable routes marked in blue)

The vessel Vos Rosinante has been contracted to carry out the task of surveying wind turbine foundations both above and below sea level also cable routes with the aid of ROV's, vessel involved in operation can be contacted on VHF channel 16. All mariners are reminded that safety zones of 500 mtrs. Are requested during all operations whilst vessel in working position, due to vessel having a four point mooring system in place around the wind turbine vessel may be working at along with sonar survey operations along cable tracks.
