

Since it was officially opened in 2015, the 36.9MW wind farm has been powering an estimated equivalent of the energy required to power 27,000 homes every year.

The Clashindarroch Community benefit fund is supported by Foundation Scotland and run by a local panel. Since 2015 it has distributed over £2m of funding that has benefited community projects across Huntly, Strathbogie, Tap o' Noth and the Cabrach areas.

This incudes supporting a range of projects that:

Regenerate local facilities and town centres Support local businesses and start ups Develop sustainable transport Support young people and sports clubs as well as services and centres for the most vulnerable in society.

Most notably this funding has also helped draw in over £10m of matched funding ino the area.
