



Autumn 2024 update

Welcome to the Autumn/Winter 2024 update from Vattenfall in South West Scotland.

Vattenfall's proposals for Quantans Hill Wind Farm remain in planning, with statutory stakeholders - including Dumfries & Galloway Council - and the consenting authority (the Scottish Government's Energy Consents Unti) considering our plans.

Besides contributing to renewable energy security, this major investment east of Carsphairn represents an opportunity for biodiversity gains, community benefit funding, visitor access plus an economic boost with Vattenfall's focus on supporting local jobs and businesses. Indeed, in the two years since submitting the proposal to planning, Vattenfall has continued to engage with local businesses and schools, highlighting the opportunities the wind farm could bring if consented.

Meanwhile in East Ayrshire, Vattenfall is finalising plans for South Kyle II Wind Farm east of Dalmellington. Since the second round of community consultation, we have been working through the feedback received. A Feedback Summary is now available on the project website, covering the key topics and themes raised during the consultation. The South Kyle II FAQs have also been updated. Work on a bespoke Skills & Employability Plan is also well advanced. This will build on our experience of supporting local jobs during the construction of nearby South Kyle Wind Farm, and consider new opportunities to boost local employment in partnership with key local stakeholders.

The South Kyle II Wind Farm proposals are set to be submitted to planning early next year. Full details will be published at the time and we will continue to engage with local communities and stakeholders throughout.

STEM, skills and schools

Across 2024, Vattenfall attended almost 30 skills, careers and STEM focussed events, visits and meetings in south west Scotland. We reached a combined total of over 3000 young people and stakeholders from Dumfries & Galloway and Ayrshire, highlighting the broad range of careers and job opportunities that can come with wind farm development.

Between October and December 2024, this included a careers fair at Robert Burns Academy; delivering classroom presentations to Logan Primary, Langholm Academy and an Action for Children programme at Doon Academy; conducting mock interviews at North West Campus in Dumfries; supporting Patna Primary School's Christmas activities; meeting P7s from Dalmellington, Bellsbank, Patna and Littlemill Primaries plus S1s at Doon Academy's transition careers clinic; joining stakeholders to celebrate the work of Developing Young Workforce's Innovation Programme in Ayrshire; and being part of the DYWD&G's Bridge to Your Future careers fair in Dumfries.

All of these conversations about jobs, careers, apprenticeships and the world of renewables have been illuminating, and are helping us prepare our plans to support local jobs through our projects at Quantans Hill and South Kyle II. We'll be continuing this programme in 2025, so if your school or event would like us to take part, please get in touch.

Rural education

Earlier this year, Vattenfall took part in the Glenkens Education Forum, speaking about renewables careers, forecast skills shortages and how wind farm community benefits are supporting skills development.

This event fed into research commissioned by Glenkens & District Trust on rural education and sustainability, and their recently published findings can now be viewed online. Thank you to the GDT team for the opportunity to contribute to this important discussion.
